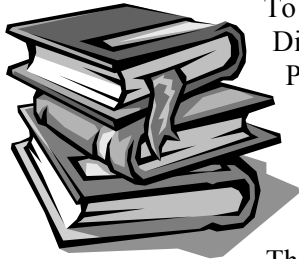


POST GRADUATE COURSES

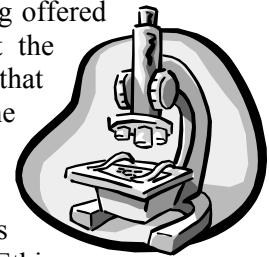
The fifth (or fourth) year **Post Graduate Course Work Strand** is being offered over one or two years. The second year will be approved provided that course work is progressing at a rate approved by the counsellor allocated to the post-graduate student.



To qualify for this award, the student must complete two Advanced Diploma of Applied Science Courses, plus the modules Professional Practice, Applied Medical Science, Ethics & Jurisprudence (a component of Applied Medical Science), Laboratory Work – Post Graduate and Manufacturing & Dispensing. Note: when Post-Graduate Certificate courses are being held by the College, these students are eligible to attend.

The award on completion of this strand is the '*Post-Graduate Award For Professional Practice*'.

The fifth (or fourth) year **Post Graduate Honours Research Strand** is being offered over one or two years. The second year will be approved provided that the proposal for the research project is approved prior to July in the first year and that the research is progressing at a rate approved by the counsellor allocated to the post-graduate student.



To qualify for this award, the student must complete a research project to the standard required by the Research Approvals Committee, plus the modules Professional Practice, Research – Post Graduate, Applied Medical Science, Ethics & Jurisprudence (a component of Applied Medical Science), Laboratory Work – Post Graduate Manufacturing & Dispensing. Note: when Post-Graduate Certificate courses are being held by the College, these students are eligible to attend.

The award on completion of this strand is the '*Post-Graduate Honours Research (Modality)*'. The title of this award would also incorporate the area of research conducted by the student.
